Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Any female gymnast affiliated to Scottish Gymnastics as a silver, competitive member who fulfils competition specific eligibility criteria.</li> <li>○ Guidance and rules as laid out in the <a href="#">WAG Classic Championships 2024</a></li> <li>○ Gymnasts who competed in any Excel Grades or British Championships in 2024 they may not enter the Classic Challenge Championships</li> <li>○ A gymnast may have competed in Home Nations, designated Regional FIG Qualifying competitions or Club Team Championships in 2024 and still be eligible to compete in Classic Challenge Championships, but where they have achieved a British ranking score of 41.50 must enter at the category minimum for their age (i.e. Silver if age 12 or above and Gold for gymnasts age 14 or above)</li> </ul>	
Age groups & rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Entries must comply with the published minimum age entry requirements.</li> <li>○ Competition groupings will be decided by the organisers based on number of entries.</li> <li>○ <i>Please note it is the coach and club responsibility of each individual gymnast to ensure the right pathway is followed and abide by the rules stated in British Gymnastics and Scottish Gymnastics handbook regarding eligibility to enter the competition.</i></li> </ul>	
Coaches	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Maximum one coach per gymnast</li> </ul> <p>It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that all coaches in attendance (minimum WA level 2) are qualified and competent for the skills being performed by their gymnasts in the competition</p>	
Competition format	<p><b>All Competitions</b>  <b>Warm Up and compete</b>  10 minutes General Warm up  1 minute per gymnast on each apparatus warm-up</p>	
Progression / Qualification	Progression to the next level is discretionary there are no move up scores. Levels may be repeated.	
Awards	Individual All-Around 1 <sup>st</sup> /2 <sup>nd</sup> /3 <sup>rd</sup> & Ribbons 4 <sup>th</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup> for each category and age group. Individual Apparatus Awards 1 <sup>st</sup> /2 <sup>nd</sup> /3 <sup>rd</sup> for each category and age group.
